
# Thank you!



### NUMBER OF TRIP LEADERS.

- Sixteen (16) trip leaders volunteered to lead or co-lead one or more of the 50 trips this term. (about ½ of the current trip leaders).
- Data is insufficient to support a correlation between Cabin Usage and the number of trip leaders.
- Per cent of active members who are legitimate candidates for designation as trip leader and who will volunteer to lead trips:
  - Not provided, but the pool of legitimate candidates is not large.

### PER CENT OF TEMPORARY MEMBER NIGHTS

#### Historically.

- Average per cent of temporary member overnights over the last 20 years is 14%.
- The year-by-year value fluctuated from 3% to 33%.
- Data for the number of temporary members that became active members is not available.

#### This year.

- Per cent of Temporary Member Overnights: 6%.
- No temporary members became active members during the term.
